

CULTURAL EXCHANGE PROGRAM - 2017

Program Dates

June 19 – August 17, 2017

Pay Rate

- \$10.00usd per hour All roles are non-tipped
- Participants are guaranteed a minimum of 30 hours per week

Roles (Exact roles to be confirmed at a later date):

• Quick Service Food & Beverage, Merchandise, Lifeguard, Custodial, Housekeeping, Bell Services, Full Service Food & Beverage, Character Performer, Operations, Costuming

J-1 Visa:

Participants are responsible for:

- Cost of US Embassy/Consulate appointment (2016 cost was \$190usd / 2017cost: HK\$1280)
- SEVIS Fee to US Embassy/Consulate (2017 cost is \$35usd)

Medical Insurance:

- Participants must obtain medical insurance for the length of the program from Lloyd's of London.
 Details to follow.
- Medical insurance (compulsory and required by Disney) HK\$2,800 (approx.)
- Travel Insurance will be around \$600 for 10 weeks to be arranged by Lingnan University

Housing

- Costs:
 - \$93 to \$124usd per week (depends on the complex and size of the unit)
 - \$154.50usd Non-refundable Program Assessment Fee (one-time fee)
 - \$200usd Housing Deposit to be paid at time of program acceptance
- · All complexes are gated with 24-hour security staff
- Participants will share a bedroom with at least one other person
- Transportation to and from work is provided
- Participants must provide own sheets, pillow, blanket, towels
- Participants must provide own food in apartment and at work

Airfare:

- Participants are responsible for round trip airfare to and from the United States around HK\$10,000 depending on the airline you choose.
- Participants are responsible for their own transportation from Orlando Airport to their Apartment Complex Front Office (approximately \$30usd)
- Participants must arrive on the exact date specified by Walt Disney World Co.

Miscellaneous:

Participant must provide own work shoes & own food. Transportation to and from work provided by Disney. Transportation from Orlando International Airport to Disney Welcome Center - approximately US\$30@

Pocket Money or Expected Living Expenses:

You are advised to prepare at least US\$500 to pay for the expenses during the first two weeks in the USA.

Subsidy from Lingnan University:

Students being offered a place in this Program is eligible to receive a subsidy of HK\$8,000.
