Minor in Finance

The Undergraduate Programmes Office of the Faculty of Business coordinates the offering of the Minor in Finance. This Minor programme is open to BBA, BBA-RIM and non-BBA students, except Finance Stream/Major students.

Students are required to complete 15 credits in total. In addition to taking the required courses listed below, students must select three electives (for BBA and BBA-RIM students) or two electives (for non-BBA students) listed below.

BUS2201 Financial Management (BBA and BBA-RIM students are exempted from this course)

FIN2200 Corporate Finance

FIN2201 Hong Kong Monetary and Financial Systems

Elective Courses

Either

6 credits (for non-BBA students) / 9 credits (for BBA and BBA-RIM students) from any 2000- to 4000-level Finance courses (FIN-coded)

<u>Or</u>

3 credits (for non-BBA students) / 6 credits (for BBA and BBA-RIM students) from any 2000- to 4000-level Finance courses (FIN-coded) **plus** one of the following relevant courses:

RIM2200 Principles of Risk Management

RIM2201 Principles of Insurance

RIM2250 Personal Risk and Financial Planning

Notes:

Students who have passed:

- 1) ECO4203 Applied Econometrics or
- 2) ECO4306 International Finance

are not permitted to take the following respective corresponding Finance course to fulfill the Minor programme requirements:

- 1) FIN2250 Introduction to Financial Econometrics or
- 2) FIN3352 International Financial Management.
