

Minor in Business

The Undergraduate Programmes Office of the Faculty of Business coordinates the offering of the Minor in Business.

All non-BBA students may qualify for a Minor in Business. Students are required to take one required course (3 credits) and four elective courses (12 credits) as detailed below:

Required Course (3 credits)

- BUS1101 Introduction to Business (deleted from 2021-22)
(This course will be counted if students have completed the course in 2020-21 or before)
- CLC9008[^] Business Ethics (from 2021-22)

Elective Courses (12 credits)

At least 3 out of the following courses:

- BUS1103 Financial Accounting
BUS2202 Organisational Behaviour
BUS2205 Marketing Management
BUS2206 Information Systems Management

If only 3 of the above elective courses are taken, one more course offered by Business Departments must also be taken, along with any prerequisites. Courses that are offered as Core Curriculum courses are excluded.

[^] According to the Academic Regulations for Undergraduate Programmes, at most two cluster courses can be double counted to fulfill both the requirement of the Core Curriculum and the requirement of any Minor programme.
