Professor LI Pang Kwong received his PhD in Government from the London School of Economics and Political Science, the University of London. His major research areas include: voting behavior and electoral politics, legislative studies, governance and institutional design, policy-making and public choice. He is the author of *Governing Hong Kong: Insights from the British Declassified Files* [管治香港：英國解密檔案的啟示] (Hong Kong: Oxford University Press, 2012), *Hong Kong from Britain to China: Political Cleavages, Electoral Dynamics and Institutional Changes* (Hampshire, UK: Ashgate, 2000), and the editor of *Political Order and Power Transition in Hong Kong* (Hong Kong: The Chinese University Press, 1997). Professor Li is the founding Director of the Public Governance Programme, which has completed over 200 commissioned survey projects.
